The Clerk was asked to write again calling their attention to it. also to ask if they could take off the corner at Mill Barn Cross where several accidents has occurred as no one cannot see a car approaching one way. The sign Post has been laid on the bank for some time.

Church Road As the bit of road leading to the Church gate from the Worlington road is not repairable by the R D Council it was suggested if the Parish provided the stone. that when the Steam Roller was at Hillbridge to ask if they would roll them in.

Present was Mr Cole Chairman Mr Tilley  
Mr Hayes. Mr Syre. Mr Gilbard Mr Kendall  
also attended who kindly canvassed the Parish  
to see who would take the children & others in  
that would be sent, she sent to say that  
the Parish would take 30 children 5 mothers  
& babies Total 40

according to Mr Pope's Lists they proposed to  
send 25 children 25 helpers & others Mr Kendall  
considered the people in the Parish would not  
agree to it. so the Clerk was requested to write  
to Mr Pope to that effect & ask him to amend his  
Lists & send the same as was requested.

Supervising Officer. Mr Kendall agreed to act as Supervising Officer  
Billing " Mr Gilbard & Mr Cole  
Precept A Precept was signed for One Pound to meet  
the expenses of the Parish Council.
